SCBA AWARDS OF DISTINCTION

NOMINEE CRITERIA

◆ HALL OF FAME ◆

The Association's Most Distinguished Award

The Association's most prestigious award recognizes individuals who have made significant lifetime contributions to the growth and development of the broadcast industry in South Carolina or South Carolinians who have made such contributions to broadcasting outside the state. Inductees have reached the highest levels of achievement and success in broadcasting on a local and/or national level. Special consideration will be given to those who've contributed to the state's broadcast industry and to the broadcast association. Nominations may come from any field of the broadcasting industry and may be posthumous recognitions. Criteria for consideration include both broadcast and non-broadcast employment history, awards and honors, and community service activities. Bronze etchings of each inductee are on permanent display in the SCBA Hall of Fame gallery in Johnson Hall at Winthrop University Department of Mass Communication.

◆ MASTERS AWARD ◆

A nominee may be any living individual who has lifetime achievements as an on-air broadcaster for radio and/or television and who has made significant contributions to broadcasting in South Carolina. Criteria for consideration include on-air broadcast employment history, awards and honors and community service activities. A sampling of the nominee's on-air work will be requested later.

◆ HONORARY LIFE MEMBER AWARD ◆

This award may be presented to any living broadcaster or individual who has demonstrated exceptional service to broadcasting either in South Carolina or outside of the state. Special consideration will be given to South Carolina broadcasters. Criteria for consideration will include both broadcast and non-broadcast employment history, awards and honors and community service activities. Nominees may include, among others; broadcast educators, legislators, owners and managers, on-air talent, broadcast technical specialists, legal and regulatory experts, or a South Carolinian representing broadcasting on a national level.
