- Owned WELP in Easley
- Signed a petition at the 1963 NAB conference requesting that President Kennedy appoint qualified broadcasters to any future vacancies in the Federal Communications Commission.
- Under Brazzell's presidency, the FCC announced it would raise the minimum operator requirements so SCBA coordinated locations for operators to take those tests. Also, Frank Blair was presented with the second annual SCBA Good Citizenship Award.
- Inducted into the SCBA Hall of Fame in 1976
- A pioneer in small, community-minded broadcasting, Brazzell supported local, state and national humanitarian causes.
