- ♦ Veteran of the US Air Force
- One of the early television reporters who brought live coverage of the day-to-day war operations to nightly newscasts during the Vietnam War
- ◆ Freelance reporter for CBS, BBC, Australian Broadcasting and Chicago Daily News in New Delhi
- Reported on all activity in Indochina and Southeast Asia from Saigon
- Provided coverage of President Ford's historic visit to China in 1975
- ◆ Served in producing capacities with ABC Radio New York, CBS New York and CONUS Communications Minneapolis
- Worked part-time for WBT-AM (Charlotte) and WRHI-AM/WRHM-FM (Rock Hill)
- Helped spearhead the broadcasting program at Winthrop University in 1988
- ◆ Professor and advisor to award-winning journalists who have been honored statewide, regionally and nationally
- ◆ Creator of "Losing Their Voices," a 30-minute documentary on AM radio stations in SC now being aired on PBS stations around the country
- Author of SCBA's 60th anniversary history and WRHI-AM's 50th anniversary history
